Sabine,

I thought I announced this a couple of days ago but can't find my post! Probably wrote it in the wrong group's messages!

I have created a replacement (experimental!) that I hope corrects the comma problem in SDRPlay2RSS. If you use a period as a decimal point, you **do not** need this change. I was able to make the changes to ver. 1.0.36 of Nathan's source code for SDRPlay2RSS. To implement the change follow these steps.

- 1. Download the new exe at radiosky.com/spec/SDRPlay2RSS-euro.exe and put it in your Program Files (x86)\Spectrograph\SDRPlay\ folder.
- 2. In that folder rename the file SDRPlay2RSS.exe to SDRPlay2RSS-original.exe
- Rename SDRPlay2RSS-euro.exe to SDRPlay2RSS.exe.
- 4. Use a text editor and find and replace the period in your SDRPlay2RSS config file, wherever it is used in a number as a decimal point. Save it.
- 5. Set your computer to your local region/ language.
- 6. Try the program.
- 7. If it does not work please let me know the symptoms and exact steps that were taken to elicit the problem.

If it does work I will be replacing the exe we distribute with RSS. It seems to work fine on my USA computer with its unsexy period decimal point.
